End User Licence Agreement

Licensor: Floating Point FZE LLC, trading as Floating Point, CWS-1V-224650, 26th Floor, Amber Gem Tower, Ajman, United Arab Emirates ("Floating Point", "we", "us").

Plain-language summary (not a substitute for the agreement): HALRON is a productivity and automation tool for your Mac, licensed to adults. It is not an AI model and not an AI service. The AI models you download and run are third-party products: you use them at your own risk, under their publishers' own licences, and Floating Point accepts no responsibility for them or their outputs. You are responsible for how you use the software and what you do with model outputs. We provide the software "as is" to the maximum extent your local law allows, and our liability is capped at what you paid. Nothing in this agreement removes consumer rights that your local law says cannot be removed. **THIRD-PARTY MODEL NOTICE. HALRON IS A TOOL THAT MANAGES AND EXECUTES AI MODELS SELECTED BY YOU. FLOATING POINT IS NOT THE PROVIDER, PUBLISHER, TRAINER, OPERATOR OR LICENSOR OF ANY AI MODEL. ALL MODELS ARE THIRD- PARTY PRODUCTS SUPPLIED UNDER THEIR PUBLISHERS' OWN TERMS. 1. Acceptance and eligibility (adults only)

1.1 This agreement is a binding contract between you and Floating Point. By checking the acceptance box, activating a licence, or installing or using HALRON, you accept this agreement.

1.2 HALRON is licensed only to adults. You represent that you are at least eighteen (18) years old and have reached the age of majority and contractual capacity in the place where you live. HALRON is not directed to, and may not be used by, minors. If you do not meet this requirement, you must not install, activate or use HALRON, and no licence is granted to you.

1.3 If you accept on behalf of a company or other entity, you confirm you have authority to bind it, and "you" includes that entity.

2. What HALRON is — and is not

2.1 HALRON is a native macOS productivity and automation tool: it lets you download, manage and run third-party artificial-intelligence models locally on Apple-silicon Macs, and organize the resulting work. The licensed product is the tool — its workspace, model management, execution environment, organization and export capabilities — not any model and not any model output.

2.2 Floating Point is not an AI model provider. Floating Point does not create, train, fine-tune, host, operate, distribute under its own licence, or control the third-party models, does not author their outputs, and does not monitor, review or moderate what you generate with them. Your decision to download and run a particular model, and every use you make of it, is yours alone.

2.3 HALRON is not a professional adviser. Outputs are not medical, legal, financial, tax, safety-critical or other professional advice, and must not be relied on as such.

3. Licence grant

3.1 Subject to this agreement and a validly acquired licence key, Floating Point grants you a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, revocable licence to install and use HALRON Essential Edition

— MetalHead on up to the number of Macs stated at purchase (currently two active Mac instances per licence), for your own personal or internal business purposes.

3.2 The licence covers the acquired major version (1.x) including maintenance and security updates that Floating Point chooses to release within that major version. Future major versions may require a new acquisition. This clause describes the current release only and is not a promise of future updates, compatibility or availability beyond mandatory statutory rights.

4. Licence activation and restrictions

4.1 HALRON requests licence activation. You may evaluate HALRON without activation for 15 days from first successful launch. After that period, HALRON presents an activation reminder at every app start. You may choose Activate Licence or Continue Using HALRON; the reminder does not lock or restrict ordinary use. Activation requires a validly acquired licence key; the price of acquisition is determined at checkout.

4.2 Whatever the activation state, HALRON will not delete, encrypt, conceal or corrupt your existing work; export and backup of your data remain available.

4.3 You must not, except to the extent a mandatory law grants you the right despite this clause: (a) copy (beyond reasonable backup), modify, or create derivative works of HALRON; (b) reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble it; (c) rent, lease, sell, sublicense, redistribute or provide it as a hosted service; (d) circumvent licence activation, entitlement or technical controls; (e) remove proprietary notices; (f) use HALRON to develop a competing product by systematic copying of its expression.

4.4 You may permanently transfer your licence to another adult who accepts this agreement, provided you deactivate all your instances and retain no copies.

5. Third-party models, licences and downloads

5.1 Models available through HALRON's catalogue are third-party products published by their respective owners under their own licences and acceptable-use terms. HALRON labels each model with its publisher, repository, revision and licence.

5.2 Before HALRON downloads a model, you must review and accept that model's licence terms and authorize the network download. Your agreement for each model is with its publisher, not with Floating Point. You are solely responsible for complying with each model's licence, acceptable-use policy, attribution and other obligations, including in respect of any output you create or distribute.

5.3 Model files are downloaded from third-party repositories (currently huggingface.co) that Floating Point does not control. Availability, integrity of upstream content, licence changes and repository terms are outside our control. HALRON verifies downloads against recorded manifests but cannot guarantee upstream conduct.

5.4 Inclusion of a model in the catalogue is a compatibility statement, not an endorsement, recommendation, or warranty of the model, its outputs, its legality in your jurisdiction, or its fitness for any purpose. Curation is limited to technical compatibility and licence-record review for the purpose of offering the download; it does not make Floating Point a party to, or guarantor of, the model or its licence.

5.5 To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Floating Point accepts no responsibility for any third-party model, including its accuracy, safety, behaviour, biases, training data, security, licence terms or changes to them, availability, or withdrawal by its publisher. Any claim relating to a model or its output lies against the model's publisher or the person who used it, not against Floating Point.

6. AI outputs — your responsibility

6.1 AI models are probabilistic. Outputs may be inaccurate, incomplete, outdated, biased, offensive, unlawful to use in certain ways, or otherwise unreliable, and may resemble third-party content. This is a known, inherent property of the technology you are choosing to use, not a defect in HALRON.

6.2 You are solely responsible for: (a) the prompts and files you provide; (b) evaluating, verifying and (where appropriate) human-reviewing outputs before any use; (c) your use, publication or distribution of outputs; and (d) ensuring your use complies with the laws applicable to you and with the relevant model licence.

6.3 To the extent permitted by law, Floating Point has no liability for any output of any model, or for any action you or others take in reliance on an output.

6.4 You must not use HALRON or any model to violate law, infringe rights of others, generate unlawful content, or in safety-critical systems (including medical devices, vehicles, weapons, or critical infrastructure) where failure could lead to death, personal injury, or severe damage.

7. Regulatory position

7.1 Floating Point provides a desktop tool for running models you select. To the extent laws regulating artificial intelligence (including the EU AI Act) impose obligations on the provider of a general-purpose AI model, those obligations rest with the model's publisher; to the extent they impose obligations on a deployer or user, they rest with you.

7.2 You are responsible for any obligations arising from your professional or commercial use of outputs (e.g. disclosure duties, sector rules, export controls).

8. Your data, your machine

8.1 HALRON is local-first: your prompts, outputs, Sessions and attachments are processed on your Mac and are not transmitted to Floating Point (see the Privacy Notice for the limited licence, model-download, and News & Announcements network traffic).

8.2 You are responsible for your own backups. HALRON provides export and backup features; use them. To the extent permitted by law, we are not liable for loss of data that a reasonable backup would have prevented.

8.3 Running large AI models is hardware-intensive. HALRON applies documented memory-admission safeguards, but you accept that model execution consumes substantial memory, storage, energy and thermal headroom on your Mac, and that behaviour on unsupported or minimum configurations may be limited.

9. Purchases, refunds, taxes

9.1 Purchases are processed by Lemon Squeezy as Merchant of Record; the checkout terms, tax handling and refund process are administered by Lemon Squeezy. Statutory refund and withdrawal rights, where applicable, are unaffected.

10. Support and updates

10.1 Floating Point may provide support and updates at its discretion. Except where mandatory law provides otherwise, this agreement does not obligate any particular support level, update cadence, future feature, or continued availability of any model in the catalogue (models may be added, changed or withdrawn following licence or safety review).

11. Warranty disclaimer

11.1 To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, HALRON is provided "AS IS" and "AS AVAILABLE", and Floating Point disclaims all other warranties, express or implied, including merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, accuracy, non-infringement, and uninterrupted or error-free operation.

11.2 Consumers: nothing in this agreement excludes or limits statutory rights that cannot be excluded or limited under the law of your habitual residence — including, for consumers in the EU/EEA and the UK, statutory conformity rights for digital content. Where such rights apply, they prevail over Section 11.1 to the extent of the conflict.

12. Limitation of liability

12.1 Nothing in this agreement excludes or limits liability that cannot be excluded by law, including liability for death or personal injury caused by negligence, for intent or gross negligence, or under mandatory product-liability or consumer-protection law.

12.2 Subject to Section 12.1, to the maximum extent permitted by law, Floating Point is not liable for: (a) indirect, incidental, special, consequential, punitive or exemplary damages; (b) loss of profits, revenue, business, goodwill, or anticipated savings; (c) loss or corruption of data that reasonable backups would have prevented; (d) third-party models, repositories, services or their outputs; (e) your breach of a model licence or of law.

12.3 Subject to Sections 12.1 and 12.2, Floating Point's aggregate liability arising out of or relating to HALRON is limited to the total amount you paid for your HALRON licence.

12.4 In jurisdictions whose mandatory law does not give full effect to Sections 12.2–12.3 (including for simple negligence breaches of essential contractual duties under German-law-type regimes), liability is instead limited to the foreseeable damage typical for this type of contract.

13. Indemnity (non-consumers)

13.1 If you use HALRON in the course of a business, you will indemnify Floating Point against third-party claims, damages and reasonable costs arising from (a) your content and prompts, (b) your use or distribution of outputs, (c) your breach of this agreement or of a third-party model licence, except to the extent caused by Floating Point's own breach. This clause does not apply to consumers where such clauses are restricted by law.

14. Termination

14.1 This agreement remains in force while you use HALRON. It terminates automatically if you materially breach it and, where the breach is curable, fail to cure within 14 days of notice.

14.2 On termination you must stop using HALRON and deactivate your instances. Sections that by nature survive (5–8, 11–13, 15–16) survive. Your local data remains yours and remains exportable.

15. Governing law and disputes

15.1 This agreement is governed by the laws of the United Arab Emirates as applied in the Emirate of Ajman, excluding conflict-of-law rules, and the courts of Ajman, UAE have jurisdiction — except that:

15.2 If you are a consumer, you additionally enjoy the protection of any mandatory provisions of the law of the country where you habitually reside, and nothing in Section 15.1 deprives you of the right to bring or defend proceedings in the courts of that country where applicable law grants that right.

15.3 The UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods does not apply.

16. General

16.1 This agreement, the Privacy Notice and the per-model licence acknowledgements form the entire agreement for HALRON. If a provision is held invalid, the remainder stays in force, and the invalid provision is replaced by a valid one closest to its intent, to the extent the applicable law permits such replacement.

16.2 We may update this agreement for new versions or for legal reasons; material changes will be presented for renewed acceptance and do not retroactively reduce rights in your already-acquired licence except as required by law.

16.3 You may not assign this agreement except under Section 4.4; we may assign it to a successor of the HALRON business.

16.4 Export/sanctions: you represent you are not barred from receiving software under applicable export-control or sanctions laws and will not use HALRON in violation of them.
